sequential electronic fuel-injection system, one of many systems governed by the advanced EEC-V computer which fine-tunes the engine to the requirements of the moment. The performance engineered into today's Mustang is the product of continuous refinements in both mechanical and electronic componentry, to deliver an exciting and rewarding driving experience.
